Well Kitten Program

Your kitten needs love, training, good nutrition, and good preventative medical care in order to grow into a healthy adult cat. Redwood Veterinary Hospital has designated a complete package of the preventative health care your kitten needs for his or her first year. This "Well Kitten Program" includes the following:

PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS

A complete physical examination by your veterinarian at the kitten's first visit and when the kitten is 3 months old help ensure that your kitten is in good general health and is growing properly. Your doctor will answer questions about the care and feeding of your kitten, preventative health care, spaying/neutering your kitten and any other concerns you may have.

FELINE LEUKEMIA VIRUS/ FELINE IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS

Feline Leukemia and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus are contagious, often fatal diseases of cats. Kittens can be born with these diseases. Even a healthy-appearing kitten may be infected with one or both diseases. All kittens enrolled in the Well Kitten Program are tested for these two viruses at their first visit.

VACCINATIONS ("Kitten Shots")

This is a vital component of well-kitten care. We recommend your kitten receive a complete program of vaccinations against Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia, and Feline Leukemia Virus. For optimum effectiveness, the vaccines are given every 3 weeks from the time of the first visit until your kitten is at least 16 weeks of age. The kitten Rabies vaccine is given at 3 months of age, as required by Solano County.

FECAL EXAMINATIONS AND DEWORMING

Many kittens have intestinal roundworms and some have other parasites. A microscopic fecal examination helps identify these parasites so they may be properly treated. Because round-worm infestation may not show up on fecal examination, all kittens are routinely wormed with a gentle, safe and effective medication as part of the well-kitten program.

WELL KITTEN PROGRAM SUMMARY

When enrolled in the Well Kitten Program, your kitten will receive:

- Well Kitten physical exams by your doctor
- A FeLV/FIV Virus test
- All Kitten vaccinations necessary during the first year of life

- 2 treatments for intestinal parasites
- 1 fecal parasite exam

IN ADDITION, ENROLLEMENT IN THE WELL KITTEN PROGRAM ALSO ENTITLES YOU TO DISCOUNTS ON THE FOLLOWING PRODUCTS AND SERVICES:

SPAY OR NEUTER SURGERY

We recommend spaying/neutering your kitten at six months of age. As a member of the Well Kitten Program, you receive a \$50 discount if you have your kitten's spay/neuter surgery before 1 year of age.

MICROCHIP IDENTIFICATION

With purchase of the Well Kitten Program you are entitled to a \$15 discount on the placement of an identifying microchip in your pet before 1 year of age. This is a safe and permanent way to identify your pet without surgery or tattoo.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED

The Well Kitten Program is intended to cover the basic, preventative health care for healthy kittens. The program does not cover any diagnostic tests, treatment, surgery or prescription that may be necessary for the diagnosis and treatment of any illness or injury. The Well Kitten Program expires at 1 year of age.
